¹ Many have undertaken to draw up an
account of the things that have been
fulfilled among us, ² just as they were handed
down to us by those who from the first were
eyewitnesses and servants of the word.

³ With this in mind, since I myself have
carefully investigated everything from the
beginning, I too decided to write an orderly
account for you, most excellent Theophilus,
⁴ so that you may know the certainty of the
things you have been taught.

²⁶ In the sixth month of Elizabeth's
pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to
Nazareth, a town in Galilee, ²⁷ to a virgin
pledged to be married to a man named

Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's
name was Mary. ²⁸ The angel went to her and
said, "Greetings, you who are highly
favoured! The Lord is with you."

²⁹ Mary was greatly troubled at his words and
wondered what kind of greeting this might
be. ³⁰ But the angel said to her, "Do not be
