

# “God makes us right with God”

Romans 5:1-21

## God has given us a great gift.

Verses 1 and 2

## A gift that demonstrates his great love.

Verses 6 to 10

## A gift that brings with it great privileges.

Verses 2 to 5 and 11

## A gift far greater than the reason for it to be given.

Verses 12 to 21

## A Bible Study – Romans 5:1-21

**Pray:** To begin with, pray. Ask God to teach you of Himself from his word.

**Read the passage:** Romans 5:1-11

**Questions:**

1. Since we have been justified by faith what is the “grace” (the gift of God) which we now have, and gained access to through our Lord Jesus Christ by faith in which we now stand? (See verse 1)

Think on the words “in which we now stand” that Paul uses in verse 2 to describe God’s relationship now with you and you with him. Do you gain any comfort, reassurance, encouragement from them?

2. In verses 6 to 10 what words does Paul use to describe what you once were and what God has done in Christ to demonstrate God’s love for you?
3. What has God now saved us from and what have we received from him? What gives us that confidence? (See verses 9 and 10)
4. What can we “boast in”? Why? (See the second part of verse 2 and verse 11)
5. What can we “glory in”? Why? (See verses 3 to 5)

**Read the passage:** Romans 5:12-21

6. What do we learn about “sin” from these verses?
7. What again is the “gift of God”? What has it achieved that far outperforms all that sin has?
8. Do you gain any comfort, reassurance, encouragement from verses 12 to 21? If so, share it with your group.

**Conclude with prayer:**

**In preparation for next week’s Bible Study** read ahead Romans 6:1-7:6.
